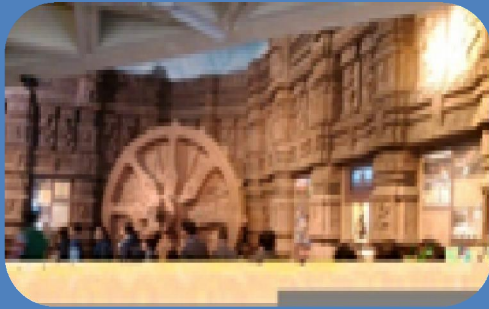
Life Skills Workshop for Students
