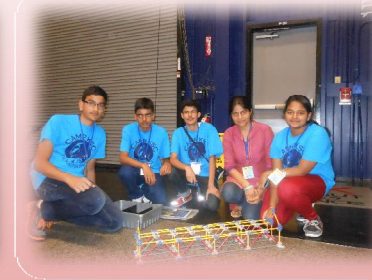
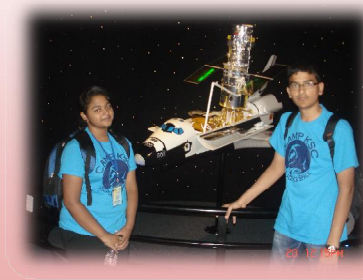
Making creative connections...

Global Education Leadership Programme

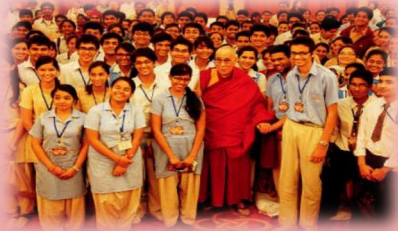

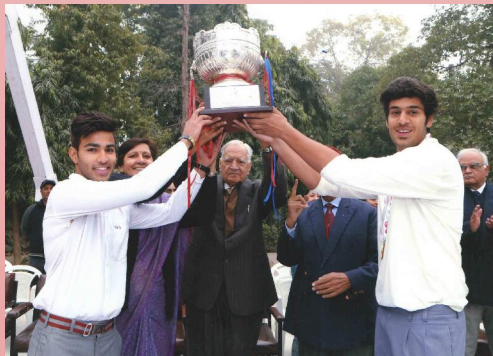
